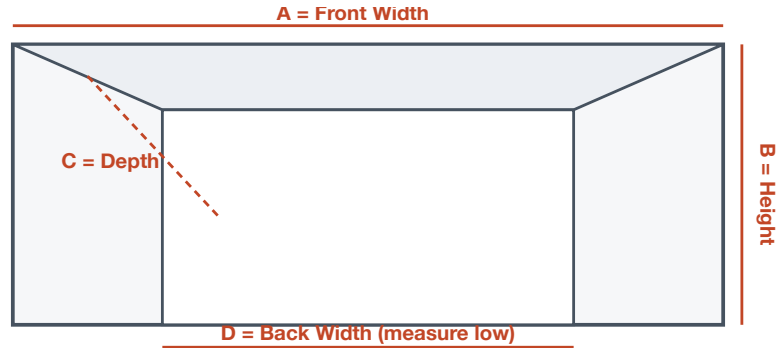


FIND MY FIREPLACE

Open Fireplace Measurement Worksheet

Four measurements stand between you and knowing exactly which inserts fit your fireplace. Print this, grab a metal tape measure, and record the smallest reading wherever a dimension varies.



Firebox Measurements

A = Front Width

_____ inches — measure top and bottom, record the smaller

B = Height

_____ inches — measure both sides; arched: record the sides

C = Depth

_____ inches — front opening to back wall

D = Back Width

_____ inches — at the back, near the floor

- Close-up of any damage or unusual features
- One view showing the whole room for context

Pro tip: fireplaces are rarely perfectly square. Measure everything at multiple points and always record the smallest number — an insert that fits the smallest reading fits everywhere.
